Betty's paternal grandparents are also Nancy and John, but they are the late Nancy and the late John Paris. Betty has one older brother and one younger sister, J. D. and Billy. J. D. is married to Lorene, they live in Miami, and they have two daughters, Martha and Nancy. Martha is married to Steve Porter and they live in Pampa. Nancy is married to Jim Burnett and they live in Wolffort, down by Lubbock. Billy is married to the late Junior Ratliff, she lives in Miami, and they have two children, Rusty and Stacy. Rusty is married to La Donna and they live in Amarillo. Stacy is married to Darrell Narron and they live in Miami.

Betty and her family lived on a farm in Laketon until she was in the sixth grade. They moved to Miami then and she went to school in Miami. They lived in town for nine months of the year and they lived back on the farm in the summers. Betty graduated from Miami High School in 1943. She went to work for the Farmer's Co-Op and worked as a secretary there for four years. The Farmer's Co-Op was a general store/grocery store. They pretty much had everything at the Co-Op. Betty fell in love with Jack Sloan and they were married on May 23, 1947. This past May, they celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary!! Carolyn Smith was John's first Speech Therapist, and Betty says that she wishes all handicapped children could have the life that John had. Betty and Jack and John attended rodeos, John rode in the rodeo parades, and he was an Honorary Member of the Pro Rodeo Cowboy's Association. AND Justin Boots sent John a pair of cowboy boots every year. He definitely was a special guy!!!

Betty has been a member of First Christian Church basically all of her life. She joined First Christian Church in Miami in the 30's. She and her parents did anything they could there and attended church and Sunday school. Betty, Jack and John joined First Christian Church in Pampa in 1976. Betty has baked pies for the bazaars in the past, and also baked for a few Bereavement Dinners. She helps out whenever she is asked by anyone. Betty's mom was in Coronado Nursing Center, and in 1983 Betty, her mom and a man named Ray Wilson began having church services there. Doris and Stan Friend, Marjie Rogers, Mary Sturgeon, Marsha Richardson and Tina Vance are all involved with church services there every Sunday, along with Betty. Betty says she really enjoys the services there as much as the residents of the nursing home do!

She quilted a few times at the Little Red Schoolhouse, but did not do it as a hobby. She has enjoyed being a wife to Jack all these years, and mostly, a mom to John. They went on many school functions, many trips with John's schools and even rode the train from Pampa to Amarillo one time. She says she has been blessed with a great life and that God has been good to her.
